

Wilderness & Remote First Aid



Required by Girl Scouts whenever an activity takes place in a location where EMS response would exceed 30 minutes.

Meets BSA Wilderness First Aid requirement.

This course prepares you with the skills necessary to respond to emergencies in situations when professional help may be delayed or unavailable. This course is especially designed to meet the needs of outdoor enthusiasts, people working in remote environments and the leaders of youth groups in outdoor pursuits.

Possession of a valid CPR certificate is a requirement for receiving a Wilderness and Remote First Aid certificate. If you need to certify or recertify, please let me know.



Some of the subjects covered include:

- Initial and Secondary Patient Assessment
- Emergency leadership
- How to call for help
- Wilderness treatment of Shock
- Head (Brain), Neck & Spinal Injuries
- Hypothermia and Heat Related Emergencies
- Bone and Joint Injuries
- Burns, Wounds and Wound Infection
- Chest and Abdominal Injuries
- Altitude Related Illnesses
- Submersion (Drowning) Incidents
- Emergency Evacuations
- Outdoor Hygiene

Participants who successfully demonstrate required skills will be awarded an American Red Cross certificate in Wilderness and Remote First Aid valid for a period of two years.
